All produce and flowers must have been grown by the exhibitor (except for floral arrangements).

Exhibitors must provide their own plants, vases, etc. The organisers can accept no responsibility for loss or damage to these.

Prizes will be awarded at the judges' discretion and will depend on the number and quality of entries. The judges' decision will be final.

The show will open to the public at 2 pm. Distribution of awards will be at 3 pm.

Entry fees 50p per class for all classes. No charge for entry to children's classes.
