Young Person of the Year (aged 25 or under)

A young person who has made remarkable and inspirational achievements and has shown enthusiasm and positivity.

Safer Broadland Award

A person in your neighbourhood who makes everyone feel a little safer. Nominees can be paid or unpaid.

Inspiration of the Year

A person who has achieved something great - personally or professionally and is an inspiration to others.

Environmental Champion of the Year

An individual, school, business or community group who has made an extra effort to make a positive impact on the environment.

Sporting Achievement of the Year

A team or individual who reached a goal in sport and have been an excellent example of good sportsmanship.

Community Group of the Year

A community group that has made a significant contribution to the residents of their local area.

Carer of the Year

A carer paid or unpaid, who a resident that +Broadland could not do without.

Volunteer of the Year

An individual who has volunteered their time to make an outstanding contribution to their community.

Business Community Support of the Year

Local business that has contributed to supporting community initiatives.

Good Neighbour or Friend of the Year

A person who has made a positive impact on someone's life. Someone who has gone the extra mile to offer help in times of trouble or just in day to day life.

Nominees must live or work in the Broadland district.

Have been involved in the activity that they have been nominated for within the last 12 months.
